Semancik Victory Park, created in 2002, is nestled in the southeast corner of your Memorial Stadium. The stadium itself was built by the 1946-47 Bremerton High Student Body through their perseverance.

The park provides students, alumni, and the community a place to purchase engraved tiles with your cherished memories commemorating individuals and events.

The victory park is unique among high school stadiums in the Pacific Northwest.....probably the entire country.

Walking into the stadium, the park begins with proud and stately two-ton granites of Bremerton, East, and West's **Walk of Champions**.

Personalized State Championships and All-State Athletes since 1928 are engraved for the world to see.....with room to expand for future endeavors.

The Path of Freedom features a personalized veterans' memorial and lighted flag plaza where the seven U.S. military branches are properly engraved between the names of all Kitsap military who lost their lives during the 20th and 21st century wars.

This area provides personalized engraved tiles commemorating our armed forces who have and will continue to keep us safe. Include yourself and those involved with the war effort whether a veteran or someone on the home front.
